

# Privacy Policy

The American College of Surgeons, the ACS Foundation, the ACS Insurance Trust, the ACS Professional Association political action committee (ACSPA SurgeonsPAC) collectively "ACS," "we," or "us") knows that you care how your information is used and shared. This Privacy Policy ("Policy") describes the types of information we collect from you and how we use and share that information (including Personal Data).

We do not knowingly collect any personally identifiable information online from children under the age of 13.

Information Collected through Technology

We collect information on how users interact with the MyATLS mobile application features and content in order to improve the user experience.

## II. How ACS Uses that Information

We do not undertake to maintain any information about you for a duration greater than necessary to provide services to you or as provided by law, rule, regulation.

ACS may use information about use of the App and aggregated information about you and other visitors to our App in order to improve our App and

perform their functions but are not authorized to share or use such information for any other purposes.

**Right to erasure:** You may ask the ACS to delete or remove your Personal Data collected through the MyATLS mobile app. The requesting user's information will be removed from the live and backup systems within 180 days. In which case, please be aware that the ACS will not be able to restore the user's progress/bookmarks/onboarding data in the MyATLS mobile app.
